### **Wapsie Valley Education Foundation Annual Benefit and Auction**

### **School Needs Assessment to Collect Community Feedback**

Ernest Hemingway noted that listening, to him was enjoyable and also enlightening. I have also heard it said that in order to learn something, a person must stop talking long enough to listen. The art of listening is also an important skill for our school district. With that in mind, the district has put together a community needs assessment survey to gather feedback from many stakeholders about the work being done for our kids and families at Wapsie Valley by the school system.

The first section of the survey will ask for a bit of demographic information. The needs assessment portion of the survey will then gather community input on the following areas: school climate, communication to and from school, the availability of school staff to families, the physical environment of our schools, teaching and learning at our schools, and "other supports" we provide for our kids. The survey will also ask about the kinds of reading and math you think kids should be exposed to by our schools, as well as the kinds of technology our students should have access to.

The collected survey data will be seen by our administrative team—Gregg Eschweiler, Jolaine Mast, and I—as well as by our school board and school improvement advisory committee. We'll summarize the data and make it available to our staff members and to the community as well.

It is very important that we, as a school system, listen—as Hemingway encouraged us to—to our stakeholders. While I can't promise that every issue raised in the survey will be addressed in a way that is satisfactory to the person who completes the survey, we hope that you will trust that we take your perspective very seriously.

Stakeholders will have a few different ways to access the survey.

- An electronic link to the survey is available on our website under the "News" items. Click on the link, and you'll be directed to the survey.
- Type in the following link in your internet web browser: <http://survey.aea267.k12.ia.us/survey/6929/3ebf/>
- Stop at the Readlyn or Fairbank Public Library and pick up a hard copy of the survey. You can return the survey to the library or to one of the schools.
- Stop at the elementary school in Readlyn or Fairbank, or the jr./sr. high school and pick up a hard copy of the survey. Return it to the school when you are finished.
- Surveys will be sent home with school-aged children, one per family.

While some of the survey questions address topics about children in school, many questions ask for input regardless of whether or not your family has a child in school. We hope that all Wapsie Valley stakeholders, whether you have a child in our public school or not, will complete the survey and provide us with your insight.

We ask that one survey per household be submitted to the school.
